Her credits also include the National Tour of *The Lion King* as well as that play's Hong Kong workshop, the Westchester Broadway Theater, the Marriott Lincolnshire productions of *Swing*! (USO/Harlem/Swing), *Saturday Night Fever* (Connie), and *Carousel* (Louise). Most recently, she performed the part of "Et Cetera" in the Houston Theatre's production of *Cats*.

"Dance isn't just a career... or even a way of life... it's a family. Dancers share the highs and lows of our chosen paths together, so the lows are never low and the highs are always a celebration. That's what I hope my experience will bring back to NJDTE, that sense of camaraderie... and fun."
